AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WORCESTER TO TAKE LAND FROM THE PUBLIC COMMON, NOW UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF WIDENING FRANKLIN STREET.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of widening the north-
2 erly side of Franklin street in the city of Worcester
3 from Main street to Salem square, the city of Worces-
4 ter is herewith authorized to take land from the
5 public common, now under the jurisdiction of the
6 parks and recreation commission of the city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
