AN ACT RELATIVE TO TEMPORARY STATE POSITIONS PERTAINING TO
NON-PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 45 of chapter 30 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 2 of chapter 210 of the acts of 1966, is
3 hereby amended by adding after paragraph 8, the following: —
4 (SA) Anything to the contrary in this section heretofore not-
5 withstanding temporary positions in the state service which
6 have been in continuous existence for a period of three years or
7 longer shall become permanent positions in the state service.
