

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance during the current year by the city council of said city, subject to the provisions of its charter.

AN ACT TO INDEMNIFY THE FORMER DIRECTOR OF ACCOUNTS *Chap.547*
FOR LOSS OF COMPENSATION.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. In order to promote the public service, there is hereby authorized to be paid to Francis X. Lang from the treasury of the commonwealth from any appropriation available for the purpose, the sum of two thousand four hundred dollars representing loss of compensation to the former director of accounts, on account of his reduction in compensation in the year nineteen hundred and fifty-three and ensuing years in violation of his rights to said compensation under section four of chapter fourteen of the General Laws and chapter six hundred and fifty-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-three.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NEW MARLBOROUGH TO *Chap.548*
APPROPRIATE ALL OR ANY PART OF THE STABILIZATION
FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT AND EQUIP A FIRE HOUSE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of section five B of chapter forty of the General Laws, the town of New Marlborough is hereby authorized by a two-thirds vote to appropriate all or any part of the stabilization funds of said town and to expend such funds for the purpose of constructing and equipping a fire house at a special town meeting called for the purpose during the current year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LEICESTER WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT *Chap.549*
TO BORROW MONEY FOR WATER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of making improvements in the water system necessary for the proper protection, maintenance and extension of said system, the Leicester Water Supply District may borrow, from time to time, within a period of three years from the passage of this act, such sums of money as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, five thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the district therefor which shall bear on their face the words, Leicester Water Supply District Improvement Loan, Act of 1957.
