AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DIVISION OF CAPITAL PLANNING AND OPERATIONS TO ACCEPT ON BEHALF OF THE COMMONWEALTH A MEMORIAL IN HONOR OF MASSACHUSETTS FIRE FIGHTERS KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 376 of Chapter 138 of the Acts of 1991 is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph:—
- 3 The commissioner of the division of capital planning and oper-
- 4 ations is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the common-
- 5 wealth a memorial to fire fighter personnel killed in the line of
- 6 duty in the commonwealth. Said commissioner shall approve the
- 7 design and materials used to construct said memorial and said
- 8 memorial shall be in keeping with the historical nature of the state
- 9 house grounds. Said memorial shall be placed in an area which is
- 10 deemed suitable by the commissioner. The cost of the construction
- 11 of said fire fighter memorial shall be paid by general contributions
- 12 from the members of various firefighter agencies within the com-
- 13 monwealth or from other interested individuals and groups.
