AN ACT GRANTING AN EASEMENT IN THE TOWN OF ORLEANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Town of Orleans is hereby authorized to
2 convey to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts acting through
3 the Department of Environmental Management an easement for
4 recreational purposes over all or portions of seven (7) parcels of
5 land presently held by the Town of Orleans for general municipal
6 purposes including conservation and recreation which parcels are
7 more fully described in a deed recorded at the Barnstable County
8 Registry of Deeds in Book 2209, Page 216. Said easement is more
9 fully bounded and described as Easement Parcel(s) "A", "B", "C",
10 "D", "E", "F", and "G", as shown on a plan on file in the office
11 of the Board of Selectmen entitled "Commonwealth of
12 Massachusetts, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
13 MANAGEMENT Division of Planning and Development, Plan
14 of Easement of Land Owned by the TOWN OF ORLEANS
15 MASS. Scale 1"=100', Date: Dec. 1989 consisting of two (2)
16 sheets. (A running description of the Easement Parcel areas are
17 on file at the office of the Board of Selectmen.)

1 SECTION 2. Said Easement to be subject to the restrictions
2 and covenants on file at the office of the Board of Selectmen. Said
3 restrictions and covenants are to be fully enumerated in the
4 Special legislation.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
