RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF ROBERT J. DEAN.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging a moral
2 obligation of the commonwealth, there shall be allowed and paid
3 out of the state treasury, subject to appropriation, to Robert J.
4 Dean of Worcester county, the sum of sixty thousand three
5 hundred and fifty-six dollars in full settlement and satisfaction of
6 an execution issued by the Superior Civil Court, Worcester county
7 on a judgment issued March fourteenth, nineteen hundred and
8 seventy-seven to said Robert J. Dean in an action of tort against
9 Reed T. Hillman for personal injuries sustained by him resulting
10 from an accident which occurred on April twenty-third, nineteen
11 hundred and seventy-five on Route 31, while the said Reed T.
12 Hillman was in the performance of his official duties as an
13 employee of the commonwealth. No payment shall be made
14 thereunder until there has been filed with the comptroller an
15 agreement signed by the said Robert J. Dean that the amount, if
16 any, paid or to be paid for legal services rendered in connection
17 with the passage of this resolve shall not exceed ten per cent of the
18 maximum amount payable hereunder.
