AN ACT RELATIVE TO WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION BENEFITS FOR MARY MALGIERI OF FALL RIVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,
2 Mary Malgieri of Fall River shall be entitled to the same
3 benefits provided by section thirty-one of chapter one hun-
4 dred and fifty-two of the General Laws, as amended by
5 chapter six hundred and sixty-six of the acts of nineteen
6 hundred and forty-eight, had this act been in effect on
7 September third, nineteen hundred and forty-eight at which
8 time her husband, John D. Malgieri, was injured.

The Constitution of Massachusetts

in the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS
IN RELATION TO THE PENSION OF THE WIDOW OF A SOLDIER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:

1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,
1. Every soldier of Ball's River shall be entitled to the same
2. benefits provided by chapter thirty-one of chapter one hun-
3. dred and eighty of the Revised Laws, as amended by
4. chapter one hundred and sixty-six of the acts of nineteen
5. hundred and forty-eight, and this act shall be in effect on
6. September third, nineteen hundred and forty-eight at which
7. time her husband, John B. Majestic, was injured.
