AN ACT ESTABLISHING A FIVE HUNDRED DOLLAR YEARLY REAL ESTATE TAX ABATEMENT FOR PERSONS SEVENTY YEARS OF AGE AND OVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 59, as appearing in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 60 the following new
3 section: —

4 Section 60A. Any city or town which accepts the provisions of
5 this section shall provide any person seventy years of age and over
6 and a resident of the commonwealth for the preceding ten years
7 with an abatement of five hundred dollars on their yearly real
8 estate tax on their domicile.
