By Mr. Broadhurst of Methuen, petition of Arthur J. Broadhurst (with the approval of the mayor and town council) for legislation to authorize the city known as the town of Methuen to grant a pension to Russell B. Moynihan. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY KNOWN AS THE TOWN OF METHUEN TO GRANT A PENSION TO RUSSELL B. MOYNIHAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the
2 contrary, and, in order to promote the public good, the Town of
3 Methuen Retirement Board is hereby authorized and directed to
4 retire Russell B. Moynihan. The annual amount of pension
5 payable shall be calculated based upon a formula for a super-
6 annuation retirement at age fifty-five with twenty-eight years of
7 service. Such individual may retire upon the effective date of
8 this act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect immediately upon its
2 passage.
