RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO COMPULSORY BASIC PROTECTION INSURANCE FOR ALL REGISTERED MOTOR VEHICLES AND AMENDING AND REPEALING LAWS RELATED THERETO AND CERTAIN OTHER MATTERS RELATED TO MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission, established by
2 chapter ninety-seven of the resolves of nineteen hundred and
3 sixty-eight and revived and continued under the provisions of
4 chapter five of the resolves of the current year, shall, in the
5 course of its investigation and study, consider the subject
6 matter of current house document numbered 2762, relating
7 to the abolition of the guest rule as it pertains to passengers
8 in motor vehicles.
