RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF HARRIET OINONEN OF FITCHBURG.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging a moral obliga-
2 tion of the commonwealth and subject to appropriation, there
3 shall be allowed and paid out of the state treasury to Harriet
4 Oinonen of Fitchburg the sum of five thousand dollars as reim-
5 bursement for medical and hospital expenses incurred by her and
6 for property damage to her car which was run into by a deer.
7 No payment shall be made hereunder until there has been filed
8 with the comptroller an agreement signed by Harriet Oinonen
9 that the amount, if any, paid or to be paid for legal services
10 rendered in connection with the passage of this resolve shall not
11 exceed fifteen per cent of the amount paid or payable hereunder.
