AN ACT PROVIDING FOR COST-OF-LIVING INCREASES IN PENSIONS, RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES AND ANNUITIES PAYABLE TO CERTAIN RETIRED EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 661 of the acts of 1966 as most recently
2 amended by chapter 408 of the acts of 1967 is hereby further
3 amended by striking out in section 1 of said chapter 408 in
4 lines 58 and 63 the words "six thousand dollars" and by
5 striking out in section 2, in lines 36 and 41 the words "six
6 thousand dollars".

1 SECTION 2. Section 102 of chapter 32 of the General Laws as
2 amended by chapter 408 of the acts of 1967, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out in lines 37 and 43 the words "six
4 thousand dollars".
