AN ACT

To establish a Registry of Deeds at Brockton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. There shall be established in the
2 court house at Brockton in the county of Plym-
3 outh a registry of deeds, for recording deeds,
4 plans or other instruments relating to real estate
5 situate in the city of Brockton. Said city shall
6 constitute the Brockton registry district in the
7 county of Plymouth.

1 SECTION 2. There shall be elected at the elec-
2 tion for state officers in the month of November
3 of the current year a register of deeds for said

4 Brockton district, to hold his office from and after
5 the first day of January in the year nineteen hun-
6 dred and one and until the term of office of the
7 register of deeds for said county expires.

1 SECTION 3. All laws in force when this act
2 takes effect relative to registers and registries of
3 deeds and not inconsistent herewith shall apply
4 to said Brockton registry district hereby created.

1 SECTION 4. The salary of said register shall
2 be one thousand dollars a year.

1 SECTION 5. Section two of this act shall take
2 effect upon its passage, and the remainder of this
3 act shall take effect upon the first day of January
4 in the year nineteen hundred and one.
