AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT A CERTAIN TRAFFIC INTERCHANGE ON THE MCGRATH HIGHWAY IN THE CITY OF SOMERVILLE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*
