AN ACT AMENDING THE PROVISION OF LAW PROVIDING FOR A REAL ESTATE TAX EXEMPTION FOR THE UTILIZATION OF SOLAR OR WIND POWERED SYSTEMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Clause 45 of Section 5 of Chapter 59 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in Section 2 of Chapter 734 of the Acts of 1976, is hereby  
3 amended by inserting in the third line after the word "heating" the  
4 words: — "or climate control."

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK

Section 17 of Article 12 of the Constitution of the State of New York is amended to read as follows:

Section 17. The State Board of Education shall have the honor and privilege of presenting to the Legislature a report on the condition of the public schools of the State, and on the progress of the State Board of Education, at the close of each year.
