AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A SKATING RINK IN THE BELMONT-WALTHAM AREA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
2 and directed to construct and thereafter maintain a skating
3 rink on land owned by said commission in the Belmont-
4 Waltham area. Said skating rink to be similar in construction
5 as the First Lieutenant Louis F. Porrazzo skating rink in
6 East Boston.

7 For the purposes of this act said commission may expend
8 such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-two.

SECTION 1. That the Board of Education of the City of Boston, as now constituted, be and the same be continued until the first day of January next, and until the Board of Aldermen and Board of Selectmen of the City of Boston shall otherwise order.

SECTION 2. That the Board of Education of the City of Boston, as now constituted, be and the same be continued until the first day of January next, and until the Board of Aldermen and Board of Selectmen of the City of Boston shall otherwise order.
