AN ACT REQUIRING MOTORCYCLE OPERATORS TO WEAR EYE PROTECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding after the last sentence as inserted by
3 chapter 13 of the acts of 1967, the following sentence:—
4 Every person operating a motorcycle shall wear eye protec-
5 tion conforming with such minimum standards of construc-
6 tion and performance as the registrar may prescribe.
