RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Improvements at the Danvers Insane Hospital.

- 1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 forty-three thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars to
4 be expended at the Danvers insane hospital, under the
5 direction of the trustees of said institution, for the fol-
6 lowing purposes:—
- 7 For new boilers and setting same for heating and
8 general use, the sum of twelve thousand dollars.
- 9 For an electric light plant for the hospital and building,
10 the sum of twenty-one thousand dollars.
- 11 For new machinery for the laundry, the sum of one
12 thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars.
- 13 For a telephone and call-bell system, the sum of two
14 thousand dollars.
- 15 To purchase five lots of land with buildings containing
16 about forty acres, the sum of seven thousand dollars.
