AN ACT AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF CONTRIBUTORY GROUP LIFE, ACCIDENT, HOSPITALIZATION, MEDICAL AND SURGICAL INSURANCE FOR PERSONS IN THE SERVICE OF A COUNTY, CITY, TOWN OR DISTRICT AND THEIR DEPENDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause (d) of section 2 of chapter 32B of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in section 1 of chapter 730 of the acts of 1956, is
3 hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph and inserting
4 in place thereof the following paragraph:—

5 “Employee”, any person in the service of a governmental
6 unit or whose services are divided between one or more govern-
7 mental units or between a governmental unit and the common-
8 wealth, whether such person be employed, appointed or elected
9 by popular vote, and compensation for said service is paid in any
10 manner hereinafter described. The duties of such person shall
11 require no less than twenty hours, regularly, in the service of the
12 governmental unit during the regular work week of permanent
13 or temporary employment which shall in no event include
14 seasonal employees or emergency employees; except that per-
15 sons elected by popular vote will be considered eligible employees
16 during the entire term for which they are elected regardless of
17 hours devoted to the service of the governmental unit.
