### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FURTHER CONTROL OF POLLING PLACES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 65 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after  
3 the word "place" in line 14 the following sentence:— No per-  
4 sons or materials intended to influence or ascertain the location  
5 of the voter shall be allowed within one hundred and fifty feet of  
6 the building entrance door to the polling place.
