AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION AT LARGE OF COUNCILLORS IN THE CITY OF PEABODY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 300 of the special acts of 1916 is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 5, as amended by section 1 of
3 chapter 234 of the acts of 1961, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following section:—

5 *Section 5.* The legislative powers of the city of Peabody shall
6 be vested in a city council, composed of eleven members, to be
7 elected at large by and from the qualified voters of the city.
8 One of the members shall be elected annually by the council
9 as its president. Members of the council elected as aforesaid
10 shall serve for a term of two years from the first Monday of
11 January following their election until their successors are elected
12 and qualified.
