Resolved, That the sum of \$100,000 be and it is hereby appropriated for the purpose of creating a commission to study and report on the geographical names of the United States and its possessions.

Resolved, That the sum of \$100,000 be and it is hereby appropriated for the purpose of creating a commission to study and report on the geographical names of the United States and its possessions. The commission shall be composed of five members, one of whom shall be the Secretary of the Interior. The commission shall hold its first meeting on or before the first day of July next. The commission shall report to the Senate on or before the first day of January next. The commission shall be authorized to employ such persons and to incur such expenses as may be necessary for the purpose of carrying out its duties.
