AN ACT INCREASING THE COMPENSATION GRADES OF COURT OFFICERS IN THE DISTRICT COURTS IN SUFFOLK COUNTY OTHER THAN IN THE MUNICIPAL COURTS OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.
