By Mr. O'Brien of Kingston, petition of Thomas J. O'Brien and David L. Flynn (by vote of the town) that the position of plumbing inspector of the town of Halifax be exempt from the provisions of civil service law. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXEMPTING THE POSITION OF PLUMBING INSPECTOR OF THE TOWN OF HALIFAX FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The position of plumbing inspector of the town of
2 Halifax shall not be subject to the provisions of Chapter 31 of the
3 General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 1 shall not impair the
2 civil service status of any person holding the office of plumbing
3 inspector of the town of Halifax on the effective date of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
