AN ACT AMENDING THE ACT REGULATING THE ACTIVITIES OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES AND ESTABLISHING A CODE OF ETHICS FOR SAID EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 268A of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in section 1 of chapter 779 of the acts of 1962, is hereby amended
3 by striking out subsection (g) and inserting in place thereof the
4 following two subsections:—

5 (g) "City employee", a person who, with or without com-
6 pensation, performs services for or holds an office, position, em-
7 ployment or membership in a city agency, whether by election,
8 appointment, contract of hire or engagement, on a full, regular,
9 part-time, intermittent or consultant basis.

10 ($g^{1/2}$) "Town employee", a person who, for compensation,
11 performs services for or holds an office, position, employment or
12 membership in a town agency, whether by election, appoint-
13 ment, contract of hire or engagement, on a full, regular, part-
14 time, intermittent or consultant basis.
