AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LEASING BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ESSEX COUNTY OF CERTAIN LAND AND BUILDINGS THEREON IN THE TOWN OF MIDDLETON HERETOFORE USED FOR HOSPITAL PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Essex county are  
2 hereby authorized to lease certain land with the buildings  
3 thereon, situated in Middleton, Massachusetts owned by the  
4 county of Essex, and controlled by said commissioners in their  
5 capacity as trustees of Essex county hospital district and here-  
6 tofore used for hospital purposes.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
