By Mr. Morris of Everett (by request), petition of John B. Nordgren that real estate occupied for dwelling purposes by owners thereof be made exempt from taxation to the amount of five thousand dollars. Taxation.

An Act exempting Certain Real Estate from Taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section five of chapter fifty-nine of the General
- 2 Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary edition, is
- 3 hereby amended by adding the following clause:—
- 4 Thirty-sixth, Five thousand dollars shall be exempt
- 5 from taxation on all property used for dwelling pur-
- 6 poses and occupied in whole or in part as living
- 7 quarters by the owner of said property.
