Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 70E of Chapter 111 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by Chapter 720 of the Acts
3 of 1979, is hereby further amended by inserting after para-
4 graph (m) the following: —

5 (n) to be informed of alternative health service providers
6 as are licensed or approved by the Commonwealth, whether
7 or not such practitioners are members of the staff of the
8 facility.
