AN ACT IMPOSING A PENALTY UPON UNLICENSED HACKNEY CARRIAGE DRIVERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 392 of the acts of 1930, as amended by
2 chapter 408 of the acts of 1931, section 7, and chap-
3 ter 280 of the acts of 1934, is hereby further amended
4 by adding after section 3 the following new section:—
5 *Section 3A.* Any person found guilty of violating
6 the preceding section shall be punished by a fine of
7 not more than fifty dollars.
