By Mr. MacLean, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1133) of William Q. MacLean, Jr., for legislation relative to the funding of certain water service in the town of Dartmouth. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FUNDING OF CERTAIN WATER SERVICE IN THE TOWN OF DARTMOUTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The commonwealth shall appropriate and pay a sum, not to
2 exceed one million four hundred and sixty-nine thousand dollars
3 for the cost of bringing municipal water service from its terminus
4 on Old Fall River road in the town of Dartmouth to the residents
5 of North Hixville road who reside in the area of the location of
6 the Resolve Inc., Superfund Hazardous Waste Site in said town.
