AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF REVERE TO REVOKE ITS ACCEPTANCE OF THE LAW RELATIVE TO PENSIONS FOR POLICEMEN AND FIREFIGHTERS AND THEIR WIDOWS UNDER THE NON-CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The city of Revere is hereby authorized to revoke its ac-
2 ceptance of section eighty-five J of chapter thirty-two of
3 the General Laws. If said city revokes said acceptance the
4 provisions of said section eighty-five J shall not apply
5 therein. Nothing herein contained shall prevent said city
6 from again accepting the provisions of said section eighty-
7 five J after such revocation.
