RESOLVE CONTINUING THE INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE RETIREMENT LAW COMMISSION RELATIVE TO CERTAIN BENEFITS PROVIDED FOR WIDOWS AND WIDOWERS UNDER THE RETIREMENT LAW AND THE FEASIBILITY OF INCREASING SUCH BENEFITS.

1 *Resolved*, That the retirement law commission is hereby au-
2 thORIZED and directed to continue the investigation and study
3 authorized by chapter twenty-four of the resolves of nineteen
