AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE PERIODIC INSPECTION OF OIL DELIVERY TRUCKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 1 of chapter 1032 of the acts of
3 1971, is hereby further amended by adding the following
4 sentence: —

5 There shall be an inspection of oil delivery trucks every thirty
6 days.
