AN ACT PROVIDING THAT PROHIBITED PRACTICE CHARGES INVOLVING THE COMMONWEALTH AND STATE EMPLOYEES UNDER SECTION 10 OF CHAPTER 150E SHALL BE HEARD BY THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION AND NOT THE LABOR RELATIONS COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 150E of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
- 2 to said chapter the following new section: —
- 3 Section 11A. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 11,
- 4 the powers and duties of the labor relations commission under
- 5 said section are hereby transferred to the American Arbitration
- 6 Association in cases involving prohibited practice charges filed
- 7 by the commonwealth or any one of its agencies, or by a state
- 8 employee or state employees, or a state employee organization.
