AN ACT RELATIVE TO FLAMMABLE CLOTHING.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 186B of Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 1986 Official Edition is hereby amended by striking out in
- 3 line three after the words or sold as items, the words of children's
- 4 sleepwear up to and including size 14 and replacing them with
- 5 the words, of clothing.
