# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Nine

## AN ACT AMENDING CHAPTER 534 OF THE ACTS OF 1973 RELATIVE TO THE OFFICE OF CHIEF OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN OF BROOKLINE .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1            Section 1.        The first, second and third sentences in SECTION 5 in Chapter 534 of  
2            the Acts of 1973, are hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

3            SECTION 5. The board of selectmen shall appoint a chief of the fire department for a  
4            term of one year, unless a different term is otherwise determined in an employment  
5            contract established under the provisions of Section 1080 in Chapter 41 of the general  
6            laws.

7            Section 2.        This act shall take effect upon its passage.
