The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT REQUIRING EACH MUNICIPALITY TO PROVIDE LOW RENT HOUSING FOR A MINIMUM OF TWENTY PER CENT OF THE LOW INCOME ELDERLY POPULATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Each municipality in the Commonwealth shall be required
- 2 to provide adequate, decent and sanitary housing units at low
- 3 income rent levels for at least twenty per cent of the low in-
- 4 come elderly households residing in said municipality accord-
- 5 ing to the most recent and generally acceptable census data
- 6 and information.
