### RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE POLICE FORCE OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging a  
2 moral obligation of the commonwealth and of pro-  
3 moting the public good, and after an appropriation  
4 has been made therefor, there be allowed and paid  
5 out of the state treasury the total sum of six hundred  
6 and seventy dollars to William F. Cunniff, John H.  
7 Lundbohn, Geary Arnold and Fred Johnson, members  
8 of the police force of the metropolitan district com-  
9 mission, to reimburse them for payments made or  
10 incurred by them for legal services and costs incident  
11 to certain proceedings necessitated by certain erro-  
12 neous rulings of the division of civil service.
