AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TIME FOR FILING A NOTICE OF PRESENTMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 4 of chapter 258
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition,
3 is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the
4 following sentence: — If the claimant is a minor or is insane when
5 a right to bring an action first accrues, such notice of claim may
6 be presented within the time hereinbefore limited after the
7 disability is removed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January 1, 1987.
