## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Nine.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING SPORTING, HUNTING, FISHING, AND TRAPPING LICENSES FOR DISABLED VETERANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 11 of Chapter 131 of the General Laws, as appearing  
2 in the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 15, after  
3 the word seventy, by inserting the following: — or a veteran as  
4 defined in clause forty-three of section seven of chapter four who,  
5 as a result of disabilities contracted while in such wartime serv-  
6 ice and in the line of duty, have a disability rating of ten percent  
7 or more as determined by the Veterans Administration or by any  
8 branch of the Armed Forces.
