The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A CHANGE IN THE METHOD OF FILLING THE OFFICE OF CITY ASSESSOR IN THE CITY OF REVERE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of chapter 43 of the General
2 Laws to the contrary, the office of the city assessor of the city of
3 Revere shall be filled by election by the voters of the city of
4 Revere at its next biennial election. Candidates for said office
5 nominated at the preliminary election, shall be candidates for
6 election at the regular election therein by ordinary plurality
7 voting.

The Commission of Enquiry

In the Year 1838

1. The Commission of Enquiry is hereby constituted to inquire into the state of the public debt and to report thereon to the House of Commons.

2. The Commission shall consist of such persons as the House of Commons may think fit to name.

3. The Commission shall have power to call for and examine all accounts, books, papers, and documents relating to the public debt, and to require any person to produce any such accounts, books, papers, or documents, and to examine any person touching the same.
