By Mr. Piro of Somerville, petition of Vincent J. Piro that Ronald Hodgdon of the city of Somerville be authorized to take a civil service examination for the position of police officer, notwithstanding certain maximum age requirements. Public Service.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING RONALD HODGDON TO TAKE A CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION FOR POLICE OFFICER NOTWITHSTANDING THE MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the maximum age requirement
2 of chapter thirty-one of the General laws, Ronald Hodgdon of the
3 City of Somerville, shall be eligible to have taken the most recent
4 open competitive examination for police officer and, provided he
5 meets all other requirements, shall be eligible for certification and
6 appointment.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
