To accompany the petition of Edward H. Keith, mayor of the city of Brockton, that said city may be authorized to expend a certain sum of money for defraying expenses incurred by it in connection with a certain disaster. Cities.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Brockton to expend a Sum of Money for defraying Expenses incurred by it in Connection with a Certain Disaster.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Brockton is hereby
2 authorized to expend a sum not exceeding five
3 thousand dollars in defraying expenses incurred
4 by it in connection with the late disaster at the
5 factory of R. B. Grover and Company in said
6 city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
