AN ACT RELATIVE TO INSURANCE BENEFITS FOR "IN VITRO" FERTILIZATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
- 2 to the contrary no insurance company providing health insurance
- 3 shall be required to provide benefits for "in vitro" fertilization to
- 4 an unmarried woman.
