### AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MINIMUM PENSION FOR TEACHERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1994  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding after Section 7 the  
3 following new section:—

4 Section 7A. Notwithstanding any other provision of this  
5 chapter, the normal yearly amount of retirement allowance, ordi-  
6 nary disability retirement allowance or accidental disability retire-  
7 ment allowance for any public school teacher who retired with at  
8 least twenty-five years of creditable service shall not be less than  
9 ten thousand dollars.
