1 *Ordered*, That the committee on taxation is hereby author-
2 ized to sit during the recess of the general court for the purpose
3 of making an investigation and study of the subject matter of
4 current house documents numbered 503, establishing a flat ex-
5 emption of a certain sum of money due for taxes by certain
6 elderly persons; and 2861, reorganizing the income tax struc-
7 ture of the commonwealth.

8 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state
9 house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within the
10 commonwealth and may expend for clerical, legal and other
11 assistance and for expenses such sums as may be appropriated
12 therefor. Said committee shall report to the general court the
13 results of its investigation and study and its recommendations,
14 if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
15 recommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk
16 of the house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday
17 of December in the current year.
