

To accompany the petition of Charles S. Lawler relative to the term of office of the mayor of Boston. Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Term of Office of the Mayor of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section forty-five of chapter four
2 hundred and eighty-six of the acts of the year
3 nineteen hundred and nine is hereby amended by
4 striking out the words, "except as hereinafter
5 provided", at the end thereof, and substituting
6 the words:— and shall not be eligible for re-
7 election, — so as to read as follows:— *Section 45.*
8 The mayor of the city of Boston shall be elected
9 at large to hold office for the term of four years
10 from the first Monday in February following his
11 election and until his successor is chosen and
12 qualified, and shall not be eligible for re-election.

1 SECTION 2. Section forty-six of said chapter
2 four hundred and eighty-six is hereby repealed.
