

By Mr. Martin of Marblehead, petition of W. H. H. Atkins, chief of the fire department of the town of Marblehead, and another that the number and terms of office of the engineers of said department be established. Towns. Jan. 19.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Five.

An Act establishing the Number and Terms of Office of the Engineers of the Fire Department of Marblehead.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter three hundred and fifteen of
2 the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-four is
3 hereby amended by striking out section one and
4 inserting in place thereof the following:—

5 *Section 1.* Section one of chapter three of the
6 acts of eighteen hundred and twenty-nine, as
7 amended by section one of chapter fifty of the acts
8 of eighteen hundred and eighty, is hereby further
9 amended, so that the number of engineers of the
10 fire department provided to be chosen by the in-
11 habitants of the town of Marblehead at their annual
12 meeting shall be three instead of five. At the
13 annual meeting in nineteen hundred and twenty-
14 five, three engineers shall be elected, one for three
15 years, one for two years and one for one year,
16 and at each succeeding town meeting one engineer

17 shall be elected for three years. Vacancies shall be
18 filled for the unexpired term at the next annual
19 town meeting.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
