

By Mr. Greenhalgh of Harwich, petition of Haden G. Greenhalgh and Paul V. Doane relative to authorizing the Department of Environmental Management to grant a permanent easement in the town of Brewster to Elizabeth Larkin Harke in exchange for certain other land in said town. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT TO GRANT A PERMANENT EASEMENT TO ELIZABETH LARKIN HARKE IN EXCHANGE FOR CERTAIN OTHER LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Department of Environmental Manage-
2 ment, acting for and on behalf of the Commonwealth, is hereby
3 authorized to grant to Elizabeth Larkin Harke, a permanent ease-
4 ment, approved as to form by the Attorney General and approved
5 by the Deputy Commissioner of Capital Planning and Operations,
6 for a roadway to be used as ways are commonly used in the Town
7 of Brewster, shown as "Easement (60 feet wide)" on a plan of land
8 entitled "Plan of Land in Brewster, Mass. as surveyed and pre-
9 pared for Elizabeth Larkin Harke, Scale 1" = 40' dated June 8,
10 1981, Scofield Brothers, Inc., Registered Professional Engineers
11 and Land Surveyors, Route 6A — P.O. Box 101 — Orleans,
12 Mass.," and on file with the Department of Environmental Man-
13 agement.

1 SECTION 2. In consideration for said conveyance provided
2 for in Section 1, Elizabeth Larkin Harke shall convey to the
3 Commonwealth through the Department of Environmental Man-
4 agement, all right, title and interest in a certain parcel of land
5 located in the Town of Brewster, shown as Lot 1 on the above-ref-

6 erenced plan, comprising 10,001 square feet, more or less, bounded
7 and described as follows:

8 Northwesterly by a portion of land of the Commonwealth of
9 Massachusetts as shown on the hereinbefore mentioned plan,
10 129.13 feet; thence Easterly by Lot 2, 117.04 feet; thence Southerly
11 by Massachusetts State Highway Route 6A, 105.58 feet; thence
12 Westerly by a portion of land of the Commonwealth of Massachu-
13 setts, 61.58 feet.

14 This parcel contains an area of 10,001 square feet more or less.
