AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses in
the State Library.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated to be paid out of the treasury of
3 the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-
6 ber, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six,
7 to wit: —

8 For the salary of the state librarian, three thou-
9 sand dollars. [Acts 1893, chap. 86.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$3,000.)

10 For the purchase of books for the state library,
11 five thousand dollars. [Acts 1888, chap. 24.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$5,000.)

12 For such clerical assistance in the state library
13 as may be necessary, a sum not exceeding thirty-

14 five hundred dollars. [Acts 1891, chap. 24,
15 \$3,500.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$3,500.)

16 For preparing an index to current events and
17 such other matters as may be deemed important
18 by the trustees and librarian, contained in the
19 newspapers of the day, a sum not exceeding one
20 thousand dollars. [Acts 1892, chap. 140.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$1,000.)

21 For contingent expenses in the state library, to
22 be expended under the direction of the trustees
23 and librarian, a sum not exceeding eighteen hun-
24 dred dollars. [Pub. Stat., chap. 5; Res. 1856,
25 chap. 74.]

(Appropriation 1895, \$1,800.)

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
